It was reported that the Facebook page had received 190 likes and had 230 followers with the most interactions about the LM Pavilion with 1000 comments. Botley notice board and Tilbury Fields Facebook pages have been set up recently and linked to the NHPC page with reposting of content between them to reach more parishioners. Most popular posts in recent months with highest reach (200 to 500 people) were posts about the LM Pavilion consultation and the pop-up café.
