## Minutes of a meeting of the Remembrance Day Committee held on Thursday 2nd September 2021 at 7.00pm in the Seacourt Hall and via video conference

- Radio Cherwell will be contacted closer to the event.
- Graham Sillman will be contacted to put boards down for wheelchairs etc and put out
- The W.I Hall was booked and car parking arrangements made.
- Cllr Berrett would check that 15 wreaths were in the Parish Council office.
- It was agreed that a list of photographs that people want taken be made.
- It had been requested that a representative of the Caribbean Ex-Serviceman's Club be invited, however Cllr Fairclough had been unable to find someone. Suggestions were welcome.

It was asked if there were any covid restrictions this year and the Chair confirmed that, so long as there were no changes to government regulations, a full service could be held.
